



## Standard Childcare Fees

These fees apply to families who are not eligible for any government funding and represent the full, non-funded cost of childcare.

### **Additional Information**

There is no Registration Fee, only a refundable one-week deposit is required to secure child's place at the nursery. Deposit will be credited to the last invoice.

Fees are based on 52 weeks per year, paid monthly in advance.

A minimum booking of 2 Morning/Afternoon sessions, or 1 Full Day session per week is required.

Minimum Notice requirements apply, and fees are subject to review in accordance with the signed Enrolment Agreement.

The nursery will be closed on all Bank Holidays (normal charges still apply). No exchanges, credits or refunds will be given for sickness or holidays. Late Collection fee of £2 for every 1 minute. We do not provide childcare by the hour.



## Funded Childcare: Additional Voluntary Charges

It's important to know that government funding is not intended to cover the full cost of childcare. It does not include essential extras like meals, nappies, wipes, sun cream, additional hours, and trips. If you're eligible for funding, you'll still be responsible for these items.

### Additional Information

We stretch funded hours across 52 weeks of the year for full-time children. This means you receive a maximum of 10.96 hours per week for the 15 hours scheme, or 21.92 hours per week for the 30 hours scheme. Any additional hours over and above the funded entitlement will be charged at our standard rate (please refer to the standard childcare fees listed on page 1).

For every funded session, we ask parents to contribute towards to our freshly prepared meals and some of consumables such as wipes and sun cream (where applicable), as these are not covered by the funding we receive.

Costs are applied according to the session attended.

\* Please note: To remain eligible for the 30 hours scheme, parents must reconfirm their eligibility with HMRC every 3 months, or when prompted.
